

# A Single-Minded Focus!



It was the first day of the week. Having heard from Mary Magdalene that Jesus' body was missing from his tomb, Simon Peter and John ["the other disciple whom Jesus loved"], ran to see for themselves. John arrived first but did not go inside until Peter went right in and saw Jesus' face-cloth folded up in a place by itself. Then John also entered, saw, "and believed." (John 20:8).

Later that day, Jesus' disciples were huddled together behind closed doors when Jesus stood among them and said, "Peace be to you." He showed them His holey hands and His stricken side. No, I did not misspell "holey." The crucified Jesus was alive.

The painting above by Eugène Burnand (Swiss, 1850–1921) is titled, "The Disciples Peter and John Running to the Sepulchre on the Morning of the Resurrection" (1898). Whatever else you see in Burnand's painting, you cannot miss the intense single-minded focus of John and Peter. Mary's witness confused them and they were unsure of what they would see, but they clearly knew where they are going. Let this passage in John 20 (like this painting) intensify your own search for the truth! [JMS]
